Fraudulent job adverts using the Life Healthcare brand

Life Healthcare would like to warn the public to be wary of job scams which involve fraudulent advertisements using the Life Healthcare brand.

The fraudulent advertisements are predominantly placed on online recruitment websites and a "Life Careers" website which does not belong to Life Healthcare. In some instances applicants are even being requested to make an upfront payment as part of their application.

Job seekers should be wary of any job advertisement that requests some form of payment as this is not how Life Healthcare recruits new employees. Other identifiers of a potentially fraudulent Life Healthcare job advertisement may include:

- The enquiry contact number is a cell number since landline numbers are "out of order".
- A fax number is provided as only contact method.
- The application form requests banking details.
- Payment is requested with a cell number provided to be used for the payment.
- No interviews requested.
- While the position itself may well be an existing vacant position at Life Healthcare, the application process is not legitimate.
